



HEALWA Welcomes Veterinarians and Veterinary Technicians

Veterinarians and veterinary technicians joined the list of HEALWA-eligible providers during the 2019 Washington State Legislative Session, bringing HEALWA to 26 professions. Staff are working with Washington veterinary librarians and the Washington State Veterinary Medicine Association to identify key information resources to be added to HEALWA.




NNLM Evaluation Office (NEO) Data Warehouse

HSL and NEO staff are designing and building a comprehensive data warehouse to store past, present, and future data from the across National Network of Libraries of Medicine. This data warehouse will establish a unified and definitive data set on NNLM outreach, funding, and membership that will help guide future efforts and answer reporting questions.



Virtual Reality Primer

HSL published the results of its Institute of Museum and Library Services-funded virtual reality project in a comprehensive "how-to" primer for academic health sciences libraries interested in introducing virtual reality services. The primer has been downloaded more than 1,500 times, and HSL staff have presented about it at multiple conferences, including the 2019 Medical Library Assocation Conference in Chicago.



Librarians Supporting Leaf

HSL librarians have partnered with the Institute of Translational Health Sciences to provide researcher training on Leaf, UW's home-grown electronic medical record discovery tool that allows researchers to quickly identify cohorts of patients without the need for extensive programming experience. Librarian-taught Leaf classes are held in HSL's TRAIL space.
